USE-RECYCLE-RE USE

COLLECTING ALMOST 18 TONNES OF PVC

We at Pipe King understand the importance of recycling and the re use of our PVC. So when asked if we were able to collect the unwanted/unused off cuts from a project we jumped at the opportunity. Not only



were we able to prevent the filling of land we were able to recycle conduit and re-use the material to manufacture PVC product.

Pipe King are currently involved in supplying Electrical conduit for a large Electrical infrastructure where kilometres of conduit is being installed and supplied across the



State. When installing such large amounts of conduits there will always be an abundance of off-cuts and other small sections of unwanted pieces.

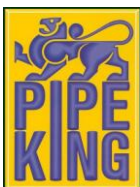


Instead of these off-cuts being taken away and turned into landfill (which is a very costly exercise and not environmentally responsible), Pipe King has formed a partnership with our customer and our local Waste Management company in the collection of this material. Here it is being returned to our plant in Caringbah



where it will be cleaned of any foreign matter before being **granulated** and reprocessed into new PVC products such as Stormwater Pipe or PVC Building Profiles to name a few. As well as removing the likelihood that this

scrap will end up in landfill, the recycling process uses only 10% of the energy required to produce the same amount of virgin PVC.
